## Facts & Figures NOTRE DAME AT NORTH CAROLINA STATE

**Series Facts:** Notre Dame is 1-2 all time against NC State. The Wolfpack beat the Irish 28-6 in 2003 and 10-3 in 2016. Notre Dame won 35-14 in 2017.

**Head Coaches:** NC State — Dave Doeren (73-54, 11th season); Notre Dame — Marcus Freeman (11-5, 2nd season).

**Noting North Carolina State:** The Wolfpack is 18-2 at home over the past three years, with losses to Boston College in 2022 (one week before Notre Dame beat BC 44-0) and Miami in 2020 by a combined four points ... Doeren's last loss in a home opener was against South Carolina on Sept. 2, 2017 ... The Wolfpack finished 8-5 in 2022, which was their fourth straight season with eight or more wins ... NC State lost to Maryland 16-12 in the Duke's Mayo Bowl Dec. 30 ... In addition to the No. 1 scoring defense in the ACC, the Wolfpack finished third in total defense, third in yards allowed per carry and second in passing yards surrendered per attempt ... Bookend tackles Anthony Belton and Timothy McKay helped allow the fourth-fewest sacks in the ACC last year with 26 ... NC State's turnover margin of plus-6 in 2022 tied for 24th in the nation. ... The Wolfpack ranked 99th in the country with 21.8 points per game last season.

## Staff Predictions

### Todd D. Burlage: NC State 24, Notre Dame 21

Notre Dame puts its 28-game regular-season winning streak against ACC teams on the line in a true road game against a solid NC State team that went 8-5 last season, including a 6-1 mark at home. The Wolfpack has also won at least eight games in three straight seasons and it has lost only two of its last 20 games at Carter-Finley Stadium since 2020. An upset alert special, Notre Dame gets clipped in this one.

### Steve Downey: Notre Dame 27, NC State 20

NC State has won 19 of the past 21 games in which it has scored at least 21 points, including going 7-0 last year (they were 1-5 when it didn't). To remedy that, the Wolfpack brought in former Virginia quarterback Brennan Armstrong and reunited him with offensive coordinator Robert Anae. The last time those two hooked up in 2021, Armstrong threw for a UVA-record 4,449 yards and 31 touchdowns.

However, NC State set Doeren-era lows for yards per carry (3.35) and rushing yards per game (113.8) last year. After holding Navy's triple option to just 126 rushing yards, the Irish defense should be able to make NC State one-dimensional and get to Armstrong enough to slow him down and escape with a hard-fought road win.

### Kyle Kelly: Notre Dame 38, NC State 30

Notre Dame quarterback Sam Hartman has averaged 36 points per game against NC State in three previous appearances at Wake Forest. I like him to lead the Irish slightly past that mark in a victory against the Wolfpack.

### Tyler Horka: Notre Dame 35, NC State 24

The Wolfpack have been a nemesis for Notre Dame quarterback Sam Hartman over the years. He had a 1-2 record against NC State while he was at Wake Forest. Two of the five games in which he's thrown three or more interceptions in his career came against the Pack, too.

Hartman didn't have this strong of a supporting cast at Wake Forest, though, and the Notre Dame defense should be good enough to give him some breathing room in the Irish's first true road game of the season.

### Jack Soble: Notre Dame 31, NC State 24

NC State should be an excellent defensive team and Hartman has struggled against NC State in the past, but the luxury of Notre Dame's run game will go a long way. A balanced Irish offensive attack should put points on the board. Armstrong threw an interception in 16 out of 21 games in 2021 and 2022; expect Notre Dame to add one more.

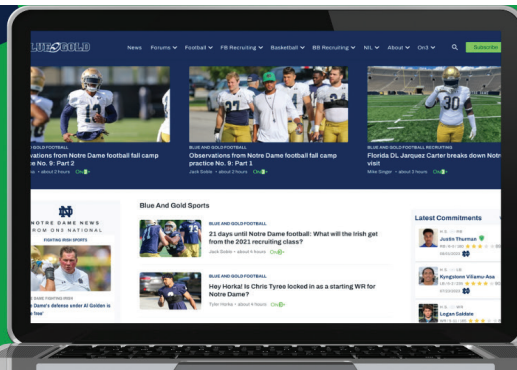
