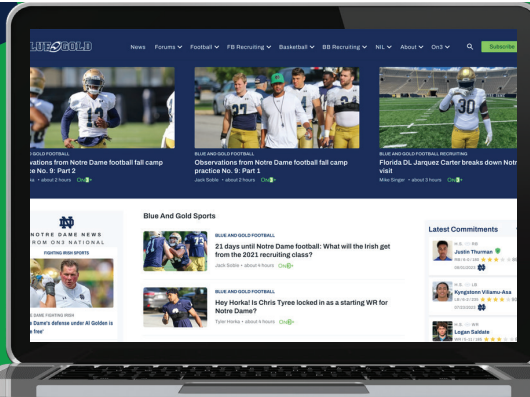

Staff Predictions

Todd D. Burlage: Notre Dame 31, Louisville 24

A new day has dawned for the Louisville football program. And it started last December with the homecoming hire of head coach Jeff Brohm, a Louisville native and a former standout Cardinals quarterback. The first-year Louisville head coach has built a prolific offense this season that ranked No. 5 in rushing offense (237.2 yards per game), No. 15 in passing offense (304.8) and No. 9 in scoring offense (43.0 points per game) through four games. This is another tough road test that Notre Dame survives.

Steve Downey: Notre Dame 49, Louisville 31

Head coach Jeff Brohm's return to his alma mater has gone about as well as could be expected. The Louisville, Ky., native and former U of L quarterback guided his team to a 5-0 mark with one of the more explosive offenses in the country. The Cardinals averaged 43.0 points per game and an impressive 7.7 yards per play (fifth in the country, one spot ahead of the Irish) before their 13-10 win at North Carolina State last week.

On the flip side, the Louisville defense has yielded 25.3 points and 424.0 yards per game against the three mediocre-at-best FBS opponents (Georgia Tech, Indiana and Boston College) it has faced. The 10-point, 201-yard effort versus North Carolina State was an improvement, but those results may actually say more about the struggling Wolfpack. I expect Sam Hartman and Co. to get back to their high-scoring ways in a shootout victory over the Cardinals.

Kyle Kelly: Notre Dame 38, Louisville 27

This feels like a game that could be much closer than it really should be, perhaps one that requires the Irish to pull away late in the fourth quarter. Notre Dame graduate student quarterback Sam Hartman averaged about 34 points per game against the Cardinals in his career as Wake Forest's starting quarterback. I think he guides the Irish to that total and surpasses it in a victory.

Tyler Horka: Notre Dame 42, Louisville 21

The Louisville defense looked feeble against a few not so good teams, particularly Georgia Tech and Boston College. The Fighting Irish will have their way with a Cardinals team that struggled to defend the pass and stop the run in those two games. Yes, the Cards' offense has been off to a hot start this season under the direction of Jeff Brohm back at his alma mater, but Notre Dame has recently stopped Brohm and quarterback Jack Plummer before when they were teamed up at Purdue, and the Irish will do it again.

This game will be more about banner days for Notre Dame quarterback Sam Hartman and running back Audric Estimé anyway, just like the last time the Irish were on the road facing a red team from the ACC.

Jack Soble: Notre Dame 45, Louisville 27

After dealing with two difficult defenses in Ohio State and Duke, Sam Hartman and company get a reprieve against a Louisville team that allowed 34 points to Georgia Tech and 28 to Boston College. The Cardinals can score, but their pass defense, which ranks 103rd with 7.6 yards per allowed attempt, won't be able to stop the Irish. Notre Dame will pull away late.

Series facts: Notre Dame is 2-1 all time against Louisville. The Irish lost the first meeting 31-28 in 2014, but they won 35-17 in 2019 and 12-7 in 2020.

Head coaches: Louisville — Jeff Brohm (5-0, first season); Notre Dame — Marcus Freeman (14-6, second season).

Noting Louisville: Brohm, now in his 10th season as a college head coach (previously with Western Kentucky and Purdue), has a career record of 71-44 ... The Cardinals are tied for 21st nationally in scoring offense (47.6 points per game) and are 30th in scoring defense (17.2) ... Louisville beat current Notre Dame quarterback Sam Hartman 48-21 last season when Hartman played for Wake Forest ... Louisville ranks sixth in the nation in red zone defense (.545), allowing just 6 touchdowns in 11 attempts ... The Cardinals had three players taken in 2023 NFL Draft: edge rushers YaYa Diaby (third round) and Yasir Abdullah (fifth), along with defensive back Kei'Trel Clark (sixth) ... Louisville has been bowl eligible every year since 2010 except 2018 under Bobby Petrino and 2020 under Scott Satterfield ... The Cardinals converted 5 of 6 fourth downs through Week 5, tied with Central Michigan for eighth-best percentage in the country (.833) ... Louisville is 23rd nationally in team yards per rush with 5.18.
