Staff Predictions

Todd D. Burlage: Notre Dame 48, Wake Forest 10

Wake Forest's offense has taken a mighty fall this season after standout quarterback Sam Hartman transferred to Notre Dame. Hartman led the Demon Deacons to eight wins, 36.1 points per game and a No. 9 national ranking in passing offense in 2022. The Demon Deacons were ranked just No. 99 in passing offense this season and were averaging only 22.2 points per outing through eight games this season.

The reunion between Hartman and many of his former teammates will remain a top storyline before this game. But none of those gushy sidebars will play a factor in a blowout Irish win.

Steve Downey: Notre Dame 45, Wake Forest 6

The Demon Deacons have really missed quarterback Sam Hartman this season. Through Week 11, Wake ranked 86th nationally in passing efficiency (126.41 rating), 94th in passing offense (200.7 yards per game) and 110th in scoring offense (20.5 points per game).

It'll hurt even more when he's on the same field with them. Wake is 61st passing defense (224.9 yards allowed per game) and 73rd in pass efficiency defense (134.1 rating), which means Hartman has an excellent chance to have the type of big day he had earlier this season in his last game at Notre Dame Stadium. The Deacons simply don't have the talent to hang with the Irish in this one.

Kyle Kelly: Notre Dame 48, Wake Forest 16

Even when Sam Hartman was on the Demon Deacons' sidelines Wake Forest could not beat the Irish. Now that he is Notre Dame's signal-caller, I like the Irish to win ... and win big in their home season finale. Hartman will be on his A-game facing his former team and I expect him to have one of the best games of his one-year Notre Dame career.

Tyler Horka: Notre Dame 38, Wake Forest 13

It'll be a happy day for Sam Hartman against his former team. Wake Forest just doesn't have enough offensive firepower to go into South Bend and beat Notre Dame — especially against a Fighting Irish defense that is playing as well as this one.

Hartman might not light up the stat sheet — he really hasn't done so since the first month of the season — but he'll make enough plays to flash his familiar smile on the sideline in the second half when the game is in hand. He'll obviously be bolstered by a Notre Dame run game that loves to grind down opponents this time of year, too. Irish win big on senior day.

Jack Soble: Notre Dame 41, Wake Forest 10

Wake Forest does not run the ball particularly well, which is the only way to beat the Irish defense. It allowed the third-most sacks (36) in the FBS through Week 9.

This won't be a revenge game for Sam Hartman — there is a lot of love in his heart for Wake Forest — but it will be emotional for a few reasons. He'll win his last game at Notre Dame Stadium.

Series facts: Notre Dame is 4-0 all time against Wake Forest, not including a vacated 38-0 Fighting Irish win in 2012. The first meeting between the two programs was in 2011, when Notre Dame won 24-17. The most recent one was in 2018, when the Irish beat the Demon Deacons 56-27.

Head coaches: Wake Forest — Dave Clawson (63-58, 10th season); Marcus Freeman (16-8, second season).

Noting Wake Forest: Smallest Power Five school by student population at 8,950, including 5,400 undergraduates ... The Demon Deacons are ranked 110th in the country in scoring offense (20.5 points per game) ... Wake Forest is 53rd in the country in scoring defense (24.4 points allowed per game). ... The Demon Deacons are fighting to stay bowl eligible for the eighth consecutive season ... Two Wake Forest players were selected in the 2023 NFL Draft: defensive tackle Kobie Turner (third round, 89th overall to the Los Angeles Rams) and wide receiver A.T. Perry (sixth round, 195th overall to the New Orleans Saints) ... The Demon Deacons rank 110th in the nation with a turnover margin of -0.6 ... Wake Forest is converting only 33.3 percent of its third downs, which is tied for 111th nationally.
