Head coaches: Central Michigan — Jim McElwain (25-22, fifth season); Notre Dame — Marcus Freeman (12-5, 2nd season)

Noting Central Michigan: The Chippewas' offense put up 219 total yards in Week 1, which placed them No. 124 out of 133 FBS teams in total yards per game through Week 0 and Week 1 ... The passing offense was the biggest let-down for the Chips; they only threw for 96 yards, which ranked 128th nationally through Week 1 in passing yards per game ... CMU head coach Jim McElwain is one of the most experienced head coaches on the Notre Dame schedule; he made his college coaching debut as a graduate assistant at Eastern Washington in 1985 ... McElwain's other stops include Montana State (1995-99), Louisville (2000-02), Michigan State (2003-05), the Oakland Raiders (2006), Fresno State (2007), Alabama (2008-11), Colorado State (2012-14), Florida (2015-17) and Michigan (2018) ... McElwain won two national championships as the offensive coordinator at Alabama; his only two head coaching stops before CMU were Colorado State and Florida ... CMU has won the West Division in the Mid-American Conference twice (2019 and 2021) under McElwain.

Staff Predictions

Todd D. Burlage: Notre Dame 35, Central Michigan 7

The Chippewas feature decent star power on defense, two unproven but talented quarterbacks on offense and a deep stable of running backs that will be the key to their success this season. None of it will be enough to topple the Irish at Notre Dame Stadium.

Steve Downey: Notre Dame 41, Central Michigan 7

Under different circumstances, this might qualify as a trap game for Notre Dame with Ohio State looming the following week. The Chippewas have won six games against Power Five opponents since 2009.

However, Central Michigan is just 1-6 in such games under head coach Jim McElwain. The lone exception was a 24-21 triumph over Washington State in the 2021 Sun Bowl, and the six setbacks have come by an average of nearly 20 points. Central Michigan doesn't possess the firepower to keep up with a Fighting Irish attack that exhibited great depth and precision in dismantling similarly overmatched opponents Navy and Tennessee State.

Kyle Kelly: Notre Dame 52, Central Michigan 10

I see this game being a lot like the 2019 Bowling Green game (52-0), not the ones against Ball State (24-16, 2018) and Toledo (32-29, 2021). Give me the Irish by 42 points.

Tyler Horka: Notre Dame 48, Central Michigan 13

Notre Dame gets one final tune-up before the big date with Ohio State next week. And that's exactly what this will be, especially for a Fighting Irish offense that is working to prove it can hang with the programs that have run the sport offensively of late.

Look for quarterback Sam Hartman to have another short but highly efficient day before handing the game over to backup Steve Angeli, just like what happened the last time the Fighting Irish played at Notre Dame Stadium.

Jack Soble: Notre Dame 45, Central Michigan 6

In Central Michigan's first game against Power Five competition this season, a Michigan State team that went 5-7 last year beat them 31-7. Notre Dame should be significantly better than Michigan State. Expect this one to go much like the Navy game did, and the countdown to Ohio State will begin Saturday night.
